THE MAY MEMORIAL CHURCH.

This beautiful church, erected to the memory of Rev. Samuel J. May by the Unitarian Congregational church of Syracuse, was dedicated with appropriate and impressive ceremonies on the afternoon and evening of Oct. 20, 1885.

The church is located on James Street, one of the principal streets of the city, is built of rock dressed gray limestone, with fine dressed trimmings and black slated

roofs.

The pews are constructed with cherry, in a crescent form, the floor descending toward the pulpit thirty inches. The rental capacity is four hundred and fifty sittings, with ample accommodation for five hundred.

On each side of the pulpit are large fire-places and mantels, with fire grates and large flues to assist ventilation.

In the rear of the auditorium, with the floor on a level with the pulpit platform, are the Sunday-school and class-rooms, which

will accommodate one hundred and fifty pupils, over which are the parlor, kitchen, and other needed conveniences for social gatherings. The cost of the church structure was \$35,000, the lot, organ, and other furnishings costing \$13,000,—all of which is paid and the society free from debt.

DR. STEPHEN TRUMBULL.

A cablegram from Callao received on Thursday by John Prain Esq., the agent of the P. S. N. Co., brought the painful announcement to the family of the decease of Dr. Stephen Trumbull of this city, on board of the S. S. *Serena* en route from Panamá to Callao. More than this fact, and that the burial took place at sea, is not yet known.

Dr. Stephen was born in Valparaiso in 1858. He was educated here in the school formerly taught by Messrs. Mackay and Sutherland until 1874, when he went to the United States and prepared for college, first at Stamford, later on at New Haven, Connecticut, where he graduated from the Yale University in a class of 121 members, in 1880. He then proceeded to Boston entering the Harvard Medical School, whence he received his diploma of M. D. in 1884, having in the interval revisited Valparaiso and spent a year at home.

After graduation he took service as resident physician in the Rhode Island Hospital, Providence, and continued there eighteen months, the regular term of service. This being closed the 1st of March, he planned to attend extra lectures in New York, and to return home in July; but being anxious about the health of his parents, he considered it to be his duty rather to come out without further delay, and accordingly left New York April 20th for Panamá en route for Valparaiso. This filial purpose he was not permitted to fulfil, and they who would have welcomed him have only to mourn his loss and recall his genial and intelligent and affectionate traits of character.
